Marle Hall Visit – June 2019

As part of the GCSE Geography course, students need to complete geography fieldwork investigations. These investigations will be externally examined in the Unit 3 paper at the end of Year 11. In order to provide this opportunity, the Geography department will be running a three day residential fieldwork course at Marle Hall from:

Sunday 9th June to Wednesday 12th June 2019 (classes 10A/Gg2, 10B/Gg1, 10B/Gg2, 10D/Gg1)

OR

Wednesday 12th June to Saturday 15th June 2019 (classes 10A/Gg1, 10C/Gg1, 10C/Gg2, 10D/Gg2)

Students will complete a river study and a traffic management study. If weather conditions permit, they will also have the opportunity to hike to the peak of Snowdon.

Over the two trips, a total of 160 places are available. In the event that the trips are oversubscribed, we will ensure students have an opportunity to collect field data on an alternative day within the local area.

The total cost of the trip will be £235. This includes all meals (apart from lunch on departure day when students will be required to bring a packed lunch), accommodation, transport, instructors and weatherproof kit. We ask for an **initial deposit of £50 to be made by Wednesday 13th March 2019**. The following payment schedule will then apply:

3rd April 2019 - £70

3rd May 2019 - £70

3rd June 2018 – £45
